Regulations of the Traditional Archery Tournament (on foot). "Legnickie Pole 1241" - 2025 edition

REGISTRATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE TOURNAMENT AND TOURNAMENT LEADER - Leszek Jęczkowski - Haris

General informations

1. Participant of the tournament - a reenactor registered and participating in the event "Legnickie Pole 1241" - edition 2025. Participants are required to wear historical costume stylized for the 13th century.

2. Participation requirements:

Bows:

Traditional and historical bows will be allowed. All kinds of sights will not be allowed and markings on the bow used for aiming. Before the tournament, the bow and arrows must be shown to the leader, who will ultimately verify the equipment before allowing participating.

- Historical bow a straight and reflective bow made entirely of natural materials (in the case of reflective bows, composite bows without visible plastic components may be permitted the decision in this matter belongs to the judge) referring in its shape to known historical specimens, which does not have to be a faithful copy of them.
- Traditional bow a straight or reflective bow made of any materials referring in its shape to known historical specimens, which does not have to be a faithful copy of them. This type of bow is distinguished by the absence of a profiled middle section and an arrow rest hole. A slight arrow rest hole is allowed, but it must not be so deep that the arrow fully lies on it. Due to the attention to the historicity of the tournament, the bow is to look like replicas of bows used in the 13th century (all inscriptions, coloured lacquers and other plastics must be hidden).

Arrows:

Arrows with wooden shafts, made of natural materials, fletchings made of natural materials with bullet form arrowheads will be allowed. The participant is to have at least 6 arrows (it is advisable to have more arrows due to possible time competitions without arrow limit and potential damage). Arrows used by individual participants should be distinguished by marking.

- 3. **Responsibility:** each participant in the tournament takes part in it at his own risk. The Participant is responsible for the proper technical condition of the arrows and the bow. Insurance of participants during the Tournament is the responsibility of the participants themselves. Responsibility for the care of underage participants is borne by their parents or guardians.
- 4. Bows as well as arrows are to be presented to the judge before the start of the Tournament. The decision of the judge is not subject to appeal.
- 5. Participation in the Tournament is tantamount to acceptance of the Regulations.
- 6. All decisions on regulations, interpretation and things not covered by the regulations are made by the leader.

Rules:

- 1. Registration takes place online until May 31. In case of vacancies, it is possible to sign up additional people at a later date, as well as on the day of the tournament. This possibility will be decided by the leader.
- 2. Archery equipment verification will take place on 21.06.2025 before the start of the tournament.
- 3. The tournament will begin on 21.06.2025 at 13:00 (right after the horseback archery tournament the time may change depending on the postponement of the horseback archery competition) on a specially fenced archery track at the event site.
- 4. No person under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other intoxicants will be allowed to take part in the Tournament.
- 5. During the tournament, we categorically observe the health ad safety, staying within the archery lanes while shooting is prohibited.
- 6. During the Tournament, each participant is required to give the command "STOP" if he sees a dangerous situation on the track, causing danger to health or life.
- 7. Distances, ways of shooting are determined before the start of each round by the judge.
- 8. The decisions of the judge are final and indisputable.
- 9. The organizers have provided prizes in kind for places I, II and III.
- 10. The organizers reserve the right to change the regulations.
